OUR PLAN

THE NEED 1 in 5 people in DuPage and Will Counties are living in poverty or low-income, and the number is increasing. Thousands of families are suffering from food insecurity, not knowing if they'll have enough food to keep their families fed and healthy. Along with food insecurity comes chronic health issues, making self-sufficiency even more difficult.

HISTORY For more than 36 years, Loaves & Fishes has been serving those in need. We began focused on food distribution. Later, programs for self-sufficiency were added. Our efforts have advanced to focus on healthy food and impactful programs for self-sufficiency. Last year, Loaves & Fishes served nearly 20,000 unique individuals. Many former clients have moved forward to productive independent lives.

HUB & SPOKE MODEL

Loaves & Fishes engaged the University of Chicago Booth Alumni Nonprofit Consultants (BANC) to conduct extensive research and analysis regarding our delivery model and geographic service area.

Our internal analysis, along with the BANC study results, led us to adopt a hub and spoke model.

HUB = distribution, storage, processing, fulfillment center

SPOKE = retail (market), client interface, other programs (CARES)

 - Provides omnichannel distribution

OUR OPPORTUNITY

PURCHASE OF A BUILDING TO SERVE AS A HUB

- Serves as the building for distribution, storage, processing, and fulfillment
- Replaces smaller one-dimensional storage facility (leased)

INCREASES CAPACITY SUBSTANTIALLY

- 3x clients served
- 40% reduction in cost to serve
- Expands geographic service area

INCREASES AMOUNT OF HEALTHIER FOOD

- More cold storage space, increases capacity for fresh produce and dairy


